IN THE CITY

More than 8,000 rose bushes bloom at the **INTERNATIONAL ROSE TEST GARDEN**. Best viewing months are May through September. rosegardenstore.org/thegardens.cfm



The winding walkways, bridged lake and open pavilions of the **LAN SU CHINESE GARDEN** frame an exquisitely arranged landscape of plants, water, stone, architecture and poetry. Built by artisans from Suzhou — Portland's Chinese sister city — the garden is an urban oasis of tranquil beauty. lansugarden.org

With its eclectic architectural design and richly decorated interior, **PITTOCK MANSION** offers a revealing glimpse into Portland's past. pittockmansion.org

The **PORTLAND AERIAL TRAM** offers a bird's-eye view of Portland, the Willamette River and snowcapped mountains. portlandtram.org

One of the most authentic Japanese gardens outside of Japan, the **PORTLAND JAPANESE GARDEN** offers an unsurpassed view of Mount Hood. japanesegarden.com

PORTLAND SATURDAY MARKET, open Saturdays and Sundays from March through December, is the nation's largest and longest-running open-air crafts market. A Portland tradition since 1974. portlandsaturdaymarket.com

AROUND THE REGION

BEAVERTON FARMERS MARKET, the largest all-agricultural market in the state, attracts 15,000-20,000 visitors each week. beavertonfarmersmarket.com

Take a behind-the-scenes tour at **BOB'S RED MILL**, which produces more than 300 healthy whole-grain flours, cereals and baking mixes. bobsredmill.com

Take the **MOUNT HOOD RAILROAD** for a scenic ride through the fertile orchards of the Hood River Valley. mthoodrr.com

Hike tree-lined trails to the top of **MULTNOMAH FALLS**, or simply enjoy the view from the full-service day lodge located at the base of the 620-foot falls. multnomahfallsdodge.com

The **NORTH WILLAMETTE VINTNERS**, a cluster of independent wineries and vineyards, are easily accessible for weekend trips or day excursions. northwillamettevintners.org

The only American-owned sake brewery in the world, **SAKÉ ONE** offers tours, plus daily tastings of this traditional Japanese beverage. sakeone.com

SCAPPOOSE BAY KAYAKING offers paddlers a wetlands/watershed area rich in cultural history and home to a variety of migratory birds, bank beavers, herons and eagles. scappoosebaykayaking.com

Mount Hood, Oregon's tallest mountain, boasts year-round skiing and an architectural treasure: **TIMBERLINE LODGE**, a National Historic Landmark built at the height of the Great Depression. timberlinelodge.com

At **TREE TO TREE ADVENTURE PARK**, visitors test their agility on a variety of courses, including zip lines, ropes and tunnels. reetotreeadventurepark.com

The **TUALATIN RIVER NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE** is home to home to nearly 200 species of birds, more than 50 species of mammals, 25 species of reptiles and amphibians, and a wide variety of insects, fish and plants. fws.gov/tualatinriver
